An Overview of "Omics" Technology

2. Provide details on the short course (short description, instructor, etc)

Instructor: Amanda Carew, University of Victoria Short Course Overview Objective: The goal of this short course is to provide a general understanding of the basic theory, application, and pros/cons of various "Omics" technologies. Course Summary: Transcriptomics are the most familiar and are already considered in some risk assessments. Microarrays have been used frequently in combination with quantitative polymerase chain reaction (QPCR) when investigating changes to the transcriptome. An overview will be given of QPCR primer design with consideration of minimum recommended information guidelines for QPCR (MIQE) and microarray (MIAME). Next-generation sequencing technology and its application for quantitative analysis using RNA-seq will be discussed. Proteomics and metabolomics make use of mass spectrometry to quantify proteins and small molecules, respectively. This technology can be very useful in profiling sublethal effects of chemicals, and potential applications and analytical considerations will be described.
